Summary of Lessons

Lesson 1:

Today in class your child learned about a man named Moses. God sent Moses to Egypt to free the Israelites, God's people, from slavery. When Pharaoh told Moses "No" he sined by disobeying God. God punished Pharaoh and all of Egypt by sending the plagues. The learned about the first five plagues that were sent by God. **Read more in Exodus 7-13**

For the craft today in class your child made a **Passover Plagues Card**. This is to help them remember how God judged Pharaoh and his people for not obeying Him.

Lesson 3:

Today in class your child learned about the last plague. The Pharaoh still had God's people in slavery. Moses told Pharaoh that God was to pass through Egypt, & that the oldest boy in each home would die. The only people that would be safe would be God's people, because of the sacrifice of a lamb. God was passing judgment on Egypt one last time. The Pharaoh finally told them to get out of Egypt.

For the craft today in class your child made a **Passover Door**. This is to help remind them about the doorways in the Passover story.

Lesson 4:

Today in class your child learned about Jesus and how God gave His Son as a sacrifice. We all sin and because of that we should all be punished for that sin like Pharaoh for disobeying God. Punishment for sin is death. Jesus took our place and died on the cross for our sin. **Read more in Romans 5**
