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**CAMPFIRE CONCEPT: Following by faith, and symbols to remember.**

**Campfire Conversations:** This week we studied from the book of Joshua. We saw how God chose Joshua, after Moses died, to lead the Israelites across the Jordan River and into their Promised Land. It was flood season at this time, and so the river was overflowing. Imagine an overflowing river. It would be a fearful site. Do you think it would be scary? \_\_\_\_\_ The people had faith and obeyed what God asked them to do. Sometimes we have to trust that God is bigger than the thing that scares us in order to obey.

God is faithful! God stopped the flow of the river so they could cross on dry ground. After they crossed the Jordan River, God instructed Joshua to have 12 men, \_\_\_\_\_ from each tribe, to get a river rock and make a memorial. It would be a sign to them, to their children, and to all of their descendants of what God had done for them.
