Summary of Lessons

Lesson 1:

Today in class your child learned about a man named John the Baptist. He would preach telling people about Jesus and that they should repent their sins and turn to God. When people would repent of their sins John the Baptist would baptize them in a river. John the Baptist baptized Jesus because Jesus wanted to be an example to others and show them what they are supposed to do.

For the craft today your child made a Jesus is Baptized. This is to help them remember that John the Baptist baptized Jesus.

Lesson 2:

Today in class we talked about Satan and how he tried to get Jesus to sin. The Holy Spirit told Jesus to go into the wilderness and fast for 40 days and 40 nights. Satan tempted Jesus multiple times but Jesus never sinned! He told Satan that you must trust in God, to not test God and to only worship God.

For the craft today in class your child made a Obeying Board Game. This is to help remind them that Jesus did not sin when Satan tried to tempt Him.

Lesson 3:

Today in class we talked about Jesus and how He rode into Jerusalem on a donkey. Many people didn't like what Jesus was teaching and talking about and wanted Him killed. This was all part of God's special plan. Jesus died to pay for our sins. He washed our sins away so we can be near God.

For the craft today your child made a Finger Paint Cross. This is to help them remember that Jesus died on the cross for our sins.

Lesson 4:

Today in class we talked about how Jesus was put into a tomb after He died. They discovered that the tomb was empty and that Jesus had risen from the dead. Jesus told His disciples to tell everyone the Good News!

For the craft today in class your child made a Empty Tomb. This is to remind them that the tomb that Jesus was put in after He died was empty and that He had risen.
