**CAMPFIRE CONCEPT:** God looks at the heart. Man looks at the outside.

Below are some suggested ideas for your family to do together, and space for you to write down how you are leading your children to know God more. Check off which activities you led your child in.

- Family Activity:** Read 1 Samuel 16 with your child, and focus on verse 7. David did not look like a king in outward appearance, but the Lord values the condition of our hearts. The condition of our heart shows in our actions and words. Have your child look at himself or herself in a mirror, and describe his or her appearance (ex. brown hair, freckles, etc.) Just like a mirror shows a reflection of what we look like on the outside, our actions and words are a reflection of what our heart looks like – Luke 6:45. Talk about some words and actions that reflect a beautiful heart that honors and pleases God.
