**CAMPFIRE CONCEPT:** God fights our battles. He gives us courage.

Below are some suggested ideas for your family to do together, and space for you to write down how you are leading your children to know God more. Check off which activities you led your child in.

- Family Activity:** Discuss 1 Samuel 17, the story of David and Goliath, with your child. David trusted that God would give him the strength and courage to defeat the giant Goliath. In life, we all face things that seem impossible or too big for us to handle. Share an example of a time that you trusted God to overcome something you thought was too big for you. Then look at these two verses together: Matthew 19:26 and Philippians 4:13. These are short, but powerful verses. It would only take a couple of minutes to memorize these with your child, and knowing them could be helpful for a lifetime.
